You can count on Connecticut Children's enhanced safety program to keep your child safe and sound – and give you peace of mind.



Safe and Sound Facilities

We've created COVID-free zones to ensure you and your child won't be exposed to illness. We've designed even stricter cleaning and disinfecting protocols, which exceed CDC standards and your own! We're serious about social distancing, and make it easy with spacious waiting areas and colorful floor markings.



Safe and Sound Appointments

Many appointments are available by Video Visit, if you prefer. Before any face-to-face visits, we ask questions about your family's COVID-19 exposure and symptoms. We also get you in and out quickly, and practice social distancing the entire time.



Safe and Sound Employees

Our team members only come to work if they're healthy. We require daily temperature and symptom screenings and have COVID-19 testing available for every team member who needs it. We're equipped with all the proper safety gear. And of course, everyone wears a mask.



Safe and Sound Surgeries

If your child has a scheduled surgery or procedure, we'll arrange for drive-through COVID-19 testing beforehand. We've also enhanced other safety protocols, allowing one caregiver per child, and sending updates from the operating room via our EASE mobile app.



Safe and Sound Visitors

We limit visitors at all of our locations, and screen everyone for temperature and COVID-19 symptoms. Everyone over the age of 2 wears a mask – one from home, or one of ours.
